Saturday 21st August-



This morning we travel to the unique garden village of Port Sunlight, founded by William Hesketh Lever in 1888 to house his soap factory workers. We visit the Museum which tells the full story of the Lever Brothers before we rejoin our coach for a guided tour of the village. We continue to Ness Gardens, created by Arthur Kilpin Bulley in 1898, who laid the

foundations of one of the UK's most beautiful botanic gardens. There is a café serving lunches, teas etc with a visitor centre, gift shop and plant sales. Later we travel to the Preston Marriott Hotel, where after checking into your room you can freshen up and relax before dinner.



Sunday 22nd August-



After breakfast we travel to the internationally renowned, Southport Flower Show, set in 34 acres of beautiful Victoria Park. The lovely seaside resort of Southport, with elegant shops on Lord Street combines wonderfully well with the Flower Show which celebrates all that is best from the gardening world. We travel home after the close of the show.
